

Job Title: Community Cricket Coach (Sessional)

Hourly Rate: £7.50 - £12 per/hr (dependant on experience)

Hours of Work: 10 – 20 hours: Flexible (Evenings & Weekends)

Job Purpose:

Under the supervision of the PYF Management Team, support the delivery of a range of cricket programmes within the community. The programmes will be targeted at young people who are currently not accessing cricket sessions, both male and female, particularly in hard to reach communities.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Support local communities to access cricket through delivering our Chance To Shine Street and Go Cricket Parks programmes
2. Support delivery of casual cricket sessions, tournaments and festivals
3. Actively engage local young people who are currently not accessing cricket sessions and encourage greater social inclusion amongst participants
4. Signposting participants to progression opportunities where they will be able to continue playing the sport
5. Record attendance and regularly monitor and review the quality of provision
6. Be reliable, trustworthy, punctual and honest
7. Confidently communicate verbally with groups of young people, parents and guardians
8. Carry out all duties and responsibilities with due regard to PYF's Policies and Procedures.
9. Ensure satisfactory levels of health and safety at sessions in accordance with PYF procedures
10. Be responsible for equipment at all sessions, ensuring that it is maintained, clean and safe.
11. Keep the PYF management team regularly informed on progress, problems and incidents at sessions, either in person or by telephone
12. To maintain a professional appearance by wearing uniform and carrying an ID badge at all times having a positive presence at all sessions
